UNIVERSITY CHORALE DIRECTOR Dr. Andrew Huish



Andrew Huish is Director of Choral Activities at Bob Jones University, where he directs the University's premier SATB choral ensemble, the Chorale, and the Chamber Singers. He also oversees the University's choral program of over 150 singers, teaches undergraduate courses in conducting and choral pedagogy, and regularly serves as a clinician and adjudicator for middle school and high school choral festivals. In 2023, the BJU Chorale was selected to compete in the 6th International Baltic Sea Choir Competition in Jūrmala, Latvia, and in 2022 performed at the fall conference for the South Carolina chapter of the American Choral Director's Association.

An award-winning choral composer, Andrew was the winner of the 2022 Indianapolis Symphonic Choir Christmas Carol Commission Competition for his original setting of "O Little Town of Bethlehem," and was the 2017 recipient of the John Ness Beck Choral Composition Award for his composition "The First Noel." His music can be found in the catalogs of Beckenhorst Press, Hinshaw Music, and Choristers Guild. Andrew has studied composition with Susan Brumfield and Joan Pinkston, as well as in masterclasses with Dan Forrest, Craig Courtney, and Howard Helvey. Also an experienced church music director and choral accompanist, Andrew currently serves as the music director for Palmetto Hills Presbyterian Church in Simpsonville, SC.

Andrew earned the Doctor of Musical Arts in Choral Conducting from Texas Tech University, where he was a student of Dr. Alan Zabriskie, and he has completed additional graduate study at Westminster Choir College.

Stephanie Huish holds a bachelor's degree in piano performance and a master's degree in piano pedagogy from Bob Jones University. She is currently an adjunct piano faculty member at Bob Jones University, where she accompanies the Chorale, teaches private non-major piano, and teaches in the pre-college music program.

Stephanie previously worked as a freelance collaborative pianist in the voice department at Texas Tech University, and for the West Texas Children's Chorus, directed by Susan Brumfield. While in Texas, she

also frequently collaborated with local secondary school band and choral programs. Prior to that, Stephanie worked as a staff accompanist at Queens University of Charlotte.

Also an adjudicator, workshop presenter, and pedagogue, Stephanie has adjudicated for the National Federation of Music Clubs (NFMC) and North Carolina Music Teachers Association Piano Performance Festival (NCMTA), served on the board of the Charlotte Piano Teachers Forum (2017-2019), presented piano pedagogy workshops in the United States and the Philippines, and prepared many of her students for successful auditions at NFMC festivals and the NCMTA Piano Performance Festival.
