#### **SYNOPSIS**

The Pirates of Penzance follows the misadventures of Frederic, a dutiful young man who has spent his childhood apprenticed to an ineffectual band of pirates located off the shores of Penzance, a resort town in the Cornwall area. Having turned 21, Frederic believes his indenture is complete, so he eagerly leaves the pirate ship to pursue an honorable life. On the shores of Cornwall, he encounters Major-General Stanley's many daughters and quickly falls in love with the spirited Mabel. Their romance blossoms instantly, but trouble follows close behind.

The pirates, learning of Frederic's departure, attempt to claim the young women for themselves, prompting the Major-General to craft an elaborate lie—he declares himself an orphan to win their pity and secure his daughters' safety. Although the ruse works in the moment, Frederic soon discovers a contractual complication: because he was born on February 29, he has technically lived only five birthdays. By the strict terms of his apprenticeship, he must return to the pirates until his twenty-first *birthday*, decades in the future.

Bound once again to the pirates, and torn between duty and love, Frederic reluctantly rejoins his old comrades, who now seek revenge on the Major-General for his deception. A chaotic showdown ensues as the bumbling local police force confronts the pirates. Ultimately, the conflict resolves when the pirates reveal their surprising loyalty to Queen Victoria, earning pardon and social acceptance. With misunderstandings cleared and obligations lifted, Frederic and Mabel are finally free to marry, bringing the operetta to a joyful, exuberant conclusion.
