Solomon is a fun, five-movement work in Klezmer style, chronicling King Solomon's life. The opening motive is based on the rhythm of the Russian reading "You shall serve the Lord your God." This motive is present in every movement either in rhythm or with the pitches. The second movement uses the famous tune "Shalom Aleichem" by Goldfarb; the opening shofar is a call to worship. The third movement is a hora. The fourth movement is an improvisation. The music comes from my *Wandering Klezmer* (2003) for clarinet solo. The fifth movement is a reprise of the first, with a *Dies Irae* near the end. Solomon was originally composed in 2010 for the Prima Trio for violin, clarinet, and piano. It was transcribed for cello and piano in 2014 and revised in 2021.
