The point of the audition is to demonstrate your current performance level. Choose works that showcase your sound, musicianship and musical strengths. Your audition will be evaluated for technical and musical proficiency. Sacred instrumental arrangements are not considered standard repertoire and may not be used for keyboard or orchestral instrument auditions. NOTE for VIDEO AUDITIONS: Electronic manipulation, reverb, or amplification of an audition is not allowed.
