Audition Requirements for Music Admission and Scholarship Consideration

The Bachelor of Music Education degree [BME] prepares you for a career of teaching and ministry in private schools, public schools, and other learning communities. This degree thoroughly prepares you to teach classroom music in elementary or secondary schools, conduct choir classes, and teach in small group lesson or individual lesson settings. The BME leads to South Carolina Department of Education licensure to teach K-12 music in elementary and secondary schools.

All applicants for the BME must audition. Your audition must display a high level of development that will allow you to begin study on the level of the listed repertoire or comparable literature. The point of the audition is to demonstrate your current performance level and your ability to communicate. Choose works that showcase your individual voice, musicianship, and musical strengths. Your audition will be evaluated for vocal beauty and technical and musical proficiency. Because much of serious vocal study and performance literature, including choral literature, is in different languages, some foreign language singing is required. Links to helpful resources of potential repertoire and foreign language diction are found below. All audition repertoire, including sacred selections, must be reflective of substantive vocal literature. Songs from pop culture are not considered substantive vocal literature and are therefore not appropriate for the audition process. NOTE for VIDEO AUDITIONS: Electronic manipulation, reverb, or amplification of an audition is not allowed.
